APPRAISAL OF SBM PROGRAMME AND PRESENT STATUS IN ASSAM

- Govt. of India launched the Saakshar Bharat Mission (SBM) on 8th September/ 2009 for the districts having female literacy of 50% or below as per 2001 census.
- Initially Five districts were taken in the year 2010-11 under Slot-I and subsequently another seven districts have been added in the year 2011-12 under Slot-II
- Presently there are 12 districts under SBM.
 Districts are: Dhemaji, Sonitpur, Darrang,
 Barpeta, Bongaigaon, Kokrajhar, Dhubri,
 Goalpara, Morigaon, Tinsukia, Karbi-Anglong & Hailakandi.

OBJECTIVE OF SBM

- Impart Functional Literacy to non literate adults in the age group of 15+
- Enable the neo-literates to continue their learning beyond basic literacy and acquire equivalency to formal education system.
- Equip the neo-literates with skill to improve their living and earning condition.
- Establish a learning society by providing opportunities to neo literates for lifelong learning.

ADULT EDUCATION CENTRES

- Well equipped multiple functional Lok Shikha Kendras (Adult Education Centres[AEC]) has been set up at Gram Panchayat level to provide institutional, managerial and resource support
- One AEC has been set up in a Gram Panchayat having the population of 5000. Total 1809 AEC in Assam.
- The adult education centres are manned by two paid Coordinators (Preraks) engaged on contractual basis. AECs are functioning from buildings provided by Gram Panchayat.
- Preraks should preferably be from marginalized groups (SCs/STs/ Minorities) and at least one of them should be a woman. A Prerak should be at least a matriculate.

IMPLEMENTATION STRATEGY OF SBM:

- Implementation of SBM programme through PRI system
- Activities and responsibilities have been delineated up to the Panchyat Gram.
- At Gram Panchayat level: Panchayat Lok Siksha Samiti
 At GP level GP President is the Chairperson and Sr Prerak is
 the Member Secretary. Sr. Prerak is the contractual
 personnel @Rs 2000/- per month for the Programme.
- * At Block level: Block lok Siksha Samiti;
 At Block level Block Panchyat President is the chairperson and BDO is the Member Secretary.
 - * District level: District Lok Siksha Samiti

 At District Level District Panchyat President is the

 Chairperson and CEO Zilla Parishad is the Member Secretary

TEACHING LEARNING PROCESS

- * Teaching learning process is implemented through Voluntary teachers . A volunteer is responsible for imparting literacy, on an average to 8-10 learners. There is no provision of remuneration for Voluntary Teachers under SBM Programme.
- * The Primers has been prepared by State Resource Centre (SRC), a registered Non-Govt. organisation which has been approved by the National Literacy Mission Authority, Govt. of India
- * The training programme has been conducted by the SRCs.

ACTIVITIES OF SBM PROGRAMME

The Main Activities of SBM programme are:

- Basic literacy
- Basic Education
- Continuing Education
- Training of Coordinators
- Community Mobilization
- Monitoring Management and Evaluation

FUNDING PATTERN:

- The share of funding between Central and State Government is in the ratio of 75:25 and in the case of North-Eastern States including Sikkim in the ratio of 90:10 respectively
- The allocation of funds to the States is based on adult non-literates population in the districts covered under the programme in various States.

Learners Assessment Test and Certification

- To assess the proficiency level of functional literacy attained by the learners
- To recognize the level of achievement through certification.
- > TWO TIMES ASSESSMENT: March & August
- Assessment through NIOS Exam.
